Do you ever wish you could hit the pause button on your monthly loan payment? With our Skip-A-Payment program, you can. Conveniently put in your request online-right from home or on-the-go with your mobile device! It only takes minutes to submit.

- ✓ Skip a loan payment up to 2 times per 12-month period.*
- ✓ Skipping a payment won't hurt your credit report!
- ✓ Eligible loans include secured consumer loans and personal installment loans.
- ✓ \$30 processing fee per loan, per request, through Online Banking or the BayPort Mobile Banking app.

A processing fee will be collected from an eligible BayPort account at the time you apply to skip a qualified loan payment. In-branch and Contact Center requests are subject to a \$35 processing fee. Interest will continue to accrue on your loan(s) during the month of the skipped payment.

*Loan terms over 60 months may only skip one (1) payment per 12-month period.

BayPort Donates \$10,000 to Support Monthly Groceries to Homebound Veterans.

The \$10,000 supports the Virginia Peninsula Foodbank partnership with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development-VA Supportive Housing (HUD-VASH) Program. The HUD-VASH Program, run locally by the Hampton VA Medical Center, will deliver monthly food boxes to nearly 500 local homebound veteran households this year alone. Previously, the Foodbank's monthly food boxes included dry and canned goods, and limited protein and produce options. However, BayPort's \$10,000 donation will help enhance the monthly food boxes to also include meat, milk, dairy, and produce products. BayPort Awards \$100,000 in Scholarships to 8 Working Adults, 11 College Students and 19 High School Seniors

The BayPort Foundation celebrates awarding \$100,000 in 11 different scholarship types to a total of 38 member students in the surrounding local communities attending a college, university, trade, or vocational school.

Since 1961, BayPort Credit Union has supported member students in funding their educational pursuits. And over that time, it has awarded over \$1 million in scholarships. Today, the credit union's philanthropic arm, the BayPort Foundation, continues its mission to enrich members' lives by providing financial support to promote education. Application evaluation criteria are comprised of GPA, academic achievements, financial need, school and community involvement, and a written essay. In addition, students must be pursuing a degree or certification at an accredited college, university, or technical school.

Earlier this year, BayPort introduced the Rowe Family Scholarship—the newest donation to the BayPort Foundation Legacy Giving Program. It is in addition to the Donald I. Steppe Memorial and the McGee Family Scholarship. All three scholarships are family gifts to honor those who share BayPort's commitment and philanthropic efforts.
